4	Identify and comment on the structure and organisation of texts, including grammatical and presentational features of the text level	A few basic features of organisation at text level identified, with little or no linked comment	4
5	Explain and comment on writers' use of language, including grammatical and literary features at word and sentence level		
6	Identify and comment on writers' purposes and viewpoints, and their overall effect of the text on the reader	Express personal responses with little awareness of writer's viewpoint or effect on reader	5

6	Identify and comment on writers' purposes and viewpoints, and their overall effect of the text on the reader	Main purposes clearly identified, often through general overview	5
