New enhanced Mathematics reports and APP

From 12th January an enhanced National Curriculum Progress Assessment pupil report for mathematics will be available. The report links each of the 'can do' and 'target' statements to the appropriate Assessment Focuses (AFs) in the Assessment of Pupils' Progress (APP) documentation by a code, for example NNS2. The letters refer to the AF and the number to the bullet point in the AF.

For KS2 the appropriate AFs are available for levels 2 to 5. The coding is as follows:

NNS	Number and the number system
OR	Operations and relationships
MM	Mental methods
MWC	Mental, written and calculator methods
SNP	Solving numerical problems
WM	Written methods
ALG	Algebra
POS	Properties of shape
PPM	Properties of position and movement
MEA	Measures
PRD	Processing and representing data
ID	Interpreting data

For KS3 the appropriate AFs are available for levels 2 to 8. The coding is as follows:

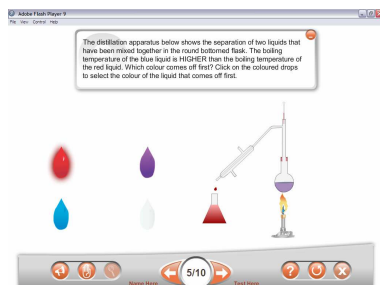
NNS	Number and the number system
CAL	Calculations
ALG	Algebra
SSM	Shape, space and measures
HD	Handling data

Enhanced CSV file reports

For teachers who wish to transfer the data from the class reports into a spreadsheet or their IMS, the csv file report has been enhanced. This now contains the same information that appears on the class report.
